

## INFORMATION FOR CREDITORS OF FOREST ENTERPRISES AUSTRALIA

Brian Silvia, Peter Krejci and Mathew Muldoon of BRI Ferrier were appointed Voluntary Administrators of Forest Enterprises Australia Limited, FEA Carbon Pty Limited, FEA Plantations Limited and Tasmanian Plantations Pty Limited by the companies on 14 April 2010.

Later that day, Tim Norman and Sal Algeri of Deloitte were appointed Receivers and Managers of Forest Enterprises Australia Limited and FEA Carbon Pty Limited and the agents for the mortgagee in possession of Tasmanian Plantations Pty Limited by the companies' bankers.

BRI Ferrier's brief is to obtain the best return for creditors by working constructively with the Receivers and Managers, Deloitte. That return, in the first instance, will arise from the sale of assets or reconstruction of the companies' business. It is too early to say what result is likely, both in terms of the timing and the amount of a return to creditors.

The first meetings of creditors in the voluntary administrations are proposed to be held on 27 April 2010. Formal notice of the meetings will be circulated to creditors shortly.
